MR. AHARON LAMSKI

Mr. Aharon Lamski, son of Rabbi Yehuda Leibush – a shochet and inspector – from Gostynin, married to Mrs. Leah, daughter of Rabbi Moshe Lichtensztajn. He was a successful cereals merchant in our town. In the year 1913, he emigrated to Israel, to settle there. When the First World War broke out, Kemal Pasha issued a decree to expel all foreign citizens from *Eretz Israel*. Mr. Aharon Lamski and his family were forced to return to Poland.

Aharon Yosef, his wife Leah and their son Nachman died in the Kutno ghetto¹, [their son] Yaakov in Warsaw. Another son, Fishel, was killed in a train accident.
