And I remember and pour out my soul for the holy death of my mother Mrs. **Hendil**, daughter of our teacher and Rabbi **Tobi z"l**, my brothers **Elhanan Tobi, Meir, Naftali**, and my only sister **Chai Sara**, all of them perished in the fierce days of the terrible war and their souls raised to heaven in the hellish fire of the city of Chelmno, where they were brought to the bonfire with the holy congregation of the town of Kutno on the 27th day of Nisan 5701 [14 April 1941].

Earth, do not cover their blood, don't be a place for their cries to rest, until the Lord shines from heaven and we take his revenge and are redeemed, may it be in our days amen.

Father R' **Israel Chaim** died a few years before the war, to whose memory I have dedicated the book "Yehuda's Wars".

Rabbi **Yitzhak Menashe Rozental**, son of Rabbi **Ze'ev Leib**

A modern chassid of *HaRim* (the *Admor* of Gur) ztz"l. He was a teacher in the city of Łęczycza, at the time of the *Malbim* ztz"l. My father passed away on the 2nd of Shevat [January 12] 1940 in the city of Krośniewice, in the same city as the Avnei Nezer ztz"l, a longtime *shamash*.

My mother and teacher **Tsharna**, a righteous woman and a righteous soul, daughter of **Shmil Trop** z"l, a righteous man and a Torah scholar in the city of Kutno.

My parents had a generation of righteous and fearless people. My brother, the eldest son **Chaim Sender** z"l, married my aunt **Surashe** z"l, the daughter of R' **Yitzhak Itzik Trop** z"l, who was a great Torah scholar and an important student in Sochaczew.

My sister **Zvia Miriam** z"l married **Abraham Lipinski** z"l, who was a chassid of Sochaczew and grandson of R' Mates Shapiro, from the city of Kalisz.

My brother Yaakov z"l, took as wife **Dvora** z"l, daughter of the *Admor* of Żychlin ztz"l.

My brother **Yeshayahu** z"l. married **Bluma** z"l, the daughter of **Leizer Berger** z"l, one of the most important Gur chassidim in the city of Łódź.

My sister **Livtza** z"l, a student in "Beit Yaakov", married to R' **Yaakov Albersztajn** z"l, grandson of the *Admor* of Gostynin ztz"l.

And add to them, their children slaughtered by the German beasts, may their names be blotted out.

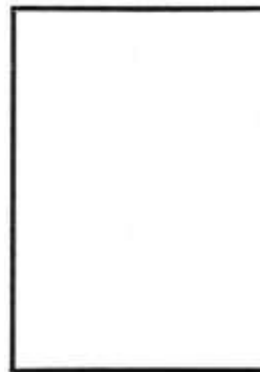
